



The CAOB **Kids in Construction** event is a design and build competition open to High School, Middle School (or equivalent) and Bermuda College students. College and High School students will be tasked with designing, planning, budgeting and building a Garden Shed. Middle School Students will be challenged to design and build mail-boxes. Sheds will be auctioned to raise money for the Scholarship Fund.

This competition has been organized to enhance the collaborative effort of students, instructors, parents, construction business owners and operators, media, government and Unions to create a better awareness of trades and applied technologies training in Bermuda.

Students currently enrolled in applied technology (trades) courses and those interested in following a career in construction will be given an opportunity to showcase their abilities to a national audience. It is our intention to help remove the misconception that construction related careers are only for those who are not academically inclined.
